Review of guidance project



- Aim:
 - To review HSE's external guidance to ensure it represents a practical and proportionate approach that helps organisations comply with health and safety law
- Objectives:
 - Reduce burdens on businesses
 - Ensure key guidance is up to date and fit for purpose
 - Consistency of message within and across publications

Publishing principles used by HSE



- Business need
- Designed to provide users with confidence in how to comply with the law
- Organised around the user's way of working
- Easy for the intended users to understand
- Based on a good understanding of users
- Easy to access
- · Reviewed and maintained

HSG179 - Current guidance





- First published in 1988, rev. 1999, & 2003
- Regarded as core industry guidance
- Generally fit for purpose
- Improvements could be made
- British Standards 2008
- Industry guidance

HSG179 review project

 - pool operators
 - H&S regulators
- Objectives:
 - provide up-to-date, authoritative guidance
 - enhance health and safety standards and compliance
